Genesis 8 *NASB*

Noah is the righteous seed who, passes the test through obedience to God's will, and survives as a remnant through the waters of death to offer a precious sacrifice.

This qualifies him to become the new humanity at the helm of a renewed creation that lives in a new covenant relationship with its Creator.
